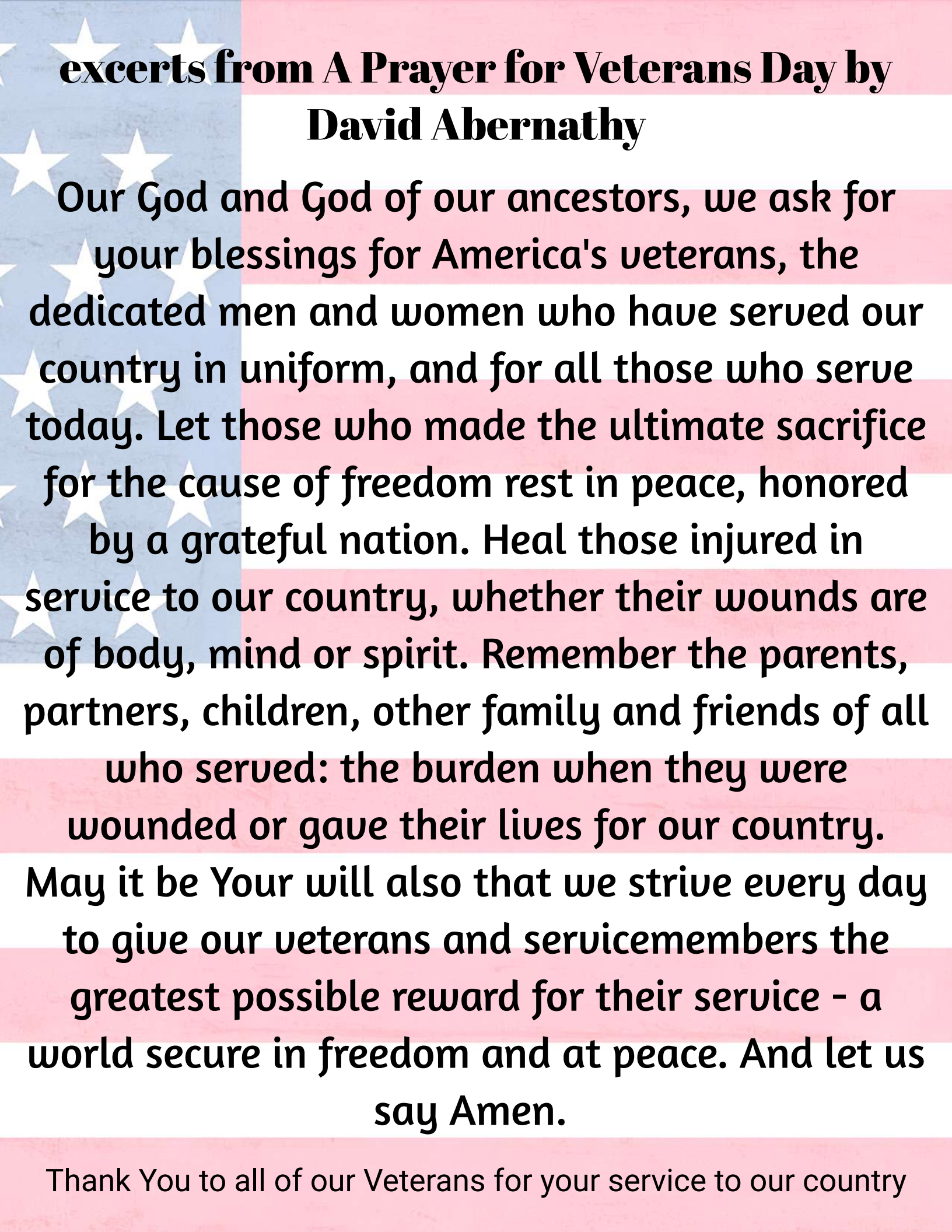

Notable Historical Events

- 1918 - WWI ended with the signing of an armistice on November 11
- 1957 - the Soviet Union launched Sputnik 2, carrying the first animal into space
- 1963 - JFK was assassinated in Dallas on November 22nd
- 1989 - the Berlin Wall begins to fall symbolizing the end of the Cold War
- 2000 - US President election between George W. Bush and Al Gore was contested and resolved by the Supreme Court
- 2008 - Barak Obama was elected as the first African-American President

November 2nd at 2:00 AM is the end of Daylight Savings Time!

Did you know that Benjamin Franklin proposed a form of daylight savings time in 1784? He wrote that Parisians could save on candles by getting out of bed earlier in the morning, making use of natural light instead. The savings, according to his calculations, would have saved the citizens of Paris about \$200 million in today's standards! Franklin's suggestion seemed to have been more of a joke than a real proposal, and nothing came of it at the time.
